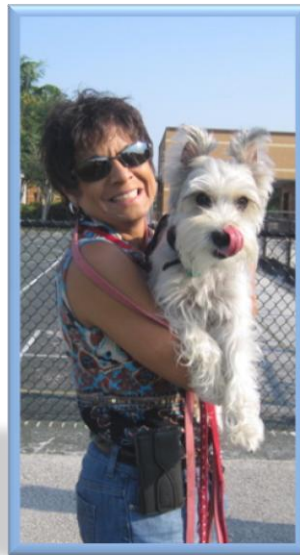
I am excited and invigorated in making this the best year ever at Panther Run!
